The West Michigan Concert WINDS was founded in the fall of 1979 as a volunteer organization, dedicated to performing quality instrumental music in the community. In 1986, the band, formerly known as the Muskegon Symphonic Band, formed an affiliation with Muskegon Community College, giving students as well as community members the opportunity to participate in the band for college credit or just for recreation.

The band draws its members from much of the West Michigan area. Many members are current or former music educators, but most are not, representing a wide variety of vocations and interests. The WINDS rehearse once a week at Muskegon Community College in order to develop their specific talents, prepare for performances, and share their love of music. Three major public concerts are offered at various theaters each season, along with performances at civic and community functions.

The WINDS have had the honor of performing at the Red Cedar Festival of Community Bands in Okemos, Michigan, since 1997. The band toured abroad in 1996, 1999, and 2005.

Under the baton of Music Director Gail A. Brechting, the WINDS were selected in 2005 as one of six community concert bands in the Midwest to perform at the Association of Concert Bands 27th Annual National Convention in Quincy, Illinois, where the band was awarded the John Philip Sousa Foundation's coveted Sudler Silver Scroll Award. This internationally recognized award for community concert bands is given in recognition of outstanding musical excellence.

The West Michigan Concert WINDS will host the ACB's 2011 National Convention in Muskegon, May 11 – 15, 2011. We invite you to join us!
